Newspaper Format: Author. "Headline." Name of Newspaper. Date: Pages. Section.

Pamphlet Format: Author. Name of Pamphlet. City: Publisher, Date.

Format: Author. "Title of article or document." Information supplier or name of institution associated with the information. Date of latest update or of posting. (DD Month YYYY format for the date). Date you accessed the information (DD Month YYYY format). <Internet address or URL>.

- **Double space**
- **If a reference is more than one line, create a hanging indent so that the second and all following lines are indented one-half inch from the left margin**
- **Alphabetize the list**
- **If no author, alphabetize by the first important word of the title.**
